Did You Know?

About Cremation

We can offer two types of cremations. The location of the crematorium and the procedure may vary.

Traditional Cremation

Traditional cremation is generally associated with fire. The crematorium uses a cremation chamber that is fueled by a gas (natural, propane, oil...etc.) that reaches between 980 -1095°C. Everything but the skeletal frame is either vapourized or emitted through a filtered stack. After the final processing the ashes are given to the family.

Bio-Cremation

Bio-cremation involves water. The crematorium uses a chamber with a water, potash, and salt-based solution that is heated to about 305°C and put under tremendous pressure (no boiling occurs). The remains are then dissolved down to their simplest molecular make-up, and the non-biohazardous fluid is drained from the unit. After the final processing the ashes are given to the family.

About Preplanning

You can preplan your services with Eternal Care Cremation, and are under no obligation. We will keep a record of your final wishes for when the need arises or you decide to prepay for your wishes.

Cremation Services starting at under \$2100

Included along with Eternal Care's professional services is documentation, initial transfer of remains, transportation to crematory/cemetery, facilities for preparation/shelter, basic preparations of remains, cremation container, urn*, and all applicable taxes.

Also included are the following disbursements; Coroner's cremation authorization, price of cremation, and death registration fee.

What is the difference between Eternal Care and a traditional funeral home?

Eternal Care specializes in basic funeral services, such as direct cremation, thereby passing the associated savings to the consumer.

We operate under a philosophy that the most basic funeral services (including taxes) should never exceed the maximum death benefit offered by Canada Pension.

What happens to the prepaid contracts in the unlikely event that a funeral business closes?

All persons with monies in trust will be contacted and issued a full refund, plus all interest that has accrued on their account.

What services are not covered within the basic package?

Burial plots, grave markers and monuments, opening and closing fees for interment, special ceremonies, reception facility and food, clergy and musician honorariums, flowers, to name the most common.

Can Eternal Care provide other services in addition to the basic services mentioned?

Whereas Eternal Care does not directly provide services involving chapel/church services and special ceremonies, or receptions, the procurement of such services by independent persons or organizations would be gladly accommodated at the request of the family.
